



THE MARK & JEAN ADAMS SCHOLARSHIP (Lancaster Scholarship Foundation, Inc.)



The Mark and Jean Adams Scholarship is created to recognize a deserving boy or girl who is pursuing a degree at either a two-year or four-year college. Primary consideration will be given to a student who is pursuing a degree in an ag-related field. Secondary consideration will be given to applicants who are pursuing a degree in a medically related field.

One scholarship in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) will be awarded annually to a qualified applicant.

If there are no applicants pursuing an ag-related or medical degree, the scholarship will be awarded to someone who exhibits citizenship, community involvement and work ethic.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicant must:

1. be a Lancaster High School full-time senior, who has completed his or her last two years of high school at Lancaster High School.
2. be enrolled in a post-secondary education program of at least two years in length.
3. complete and submit the application form prior to the announced deadline. Please be specific.
4. **submit at least one letter of recommendation from a non-school staff member.** Acceptable references must have known the applicant within the last year-and-a-half.
5. attach a high school transcript.

SELECTION:

Selection of the scholarship recipient will be made by the Lancaster Scholarship Foundation Board of Directors.

PAYMENT:

The scholarship recipient will receive payment after successfully completing his or her first semester and submitting proof of full-time enrollment in second semester at an accredited college. ***Successful completion of the first semester is defined as completing a minimum of 12 credit hours, not being on any type of academic probation status, or being dismissed from school.*** Proof of extenuating circumstances will be considered on an individual basis.
