

THE TED and HELEN ANDERSON SCHOLARSHIP





The Ted and Helen Anderson Scholarship is created to assist a senior, graduating from Lancaster High School, who is pursuing a Fine Arts degree in art, dance, music, theatre, or a similar field at either a four-year college or university or a technical college. Should there be no applicants pursuing a degree in one of the above fields, *secondary consideration* will be given to students who have been involved in the Fine Arts Program at Lancaster High School.

One scholarship in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) will be awarded annually to a qualified applicant.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Lancaster High School full-time senior, who has completed his or her last two years of high school at Lancaster High School.
- 2. Must be enrolled in a post-secondary education program of at least one year in length.
- 3. Complete and submit the application form prior to the announced deadline. Please be specific.
- 4. **Submit at least one letter of recommendation from a non-school staff community member.** Acceptable references must have known the applicant within the last year-and-a-half.
- 5. Attach a high school transcript.

SELECTION:

Selection of the scholarship recipient will be made by the Lancaster Scholarship Foundation Board of Directors.

PAYMENT:

The scholarship recipient will receive payment after successfully completing his or her first semester of schooling and proof of <u>full-time</u> enrollment in second semester at an accredited college. Successful completion of the first semester is defined as completing a <u>minimum of 12 credit hours</u>, not being on any type of academic probation status, or being dismissed from school. Proof of extenuating circumstances will be considered on an individual basis.
