



# THE NORMA COULTHARD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

(Lancaster Scholarship Foundation, Inc.)



The Norma Coulthard Memorial Scholarship is created to recognize a deserving boy or girl who is pursuing a degree at a four-year college or university. Primary consideration will be given to a student who is pursuing a degree in the field of **education** or **library science**. Secondary consideration will be given to applicants who exhibit citizenship, community involvement and work ethic.

If there are no applicants pursuing an education or library science-related field, the scholarship will be awarded to someone who exhibits citizenship, community involvement and work ethic.

One scholarship in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) will be awarded annually to a qualified applicant for ten years (2019-2028).

## QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Lancaster High School full-time senior, who has completed his or her last two years of high school at Lancaster High School.
2. Must be enrolled in a post-secondary education program of at least four years in length.
3. Complete and submit the application form prior to the announced deadline. Please be specific.
4. **Submit at least one letter of recommendation from a non-school staff community member.** Acceptable references must have known the applicant within the last year-and-a-half.
5. Attach a high school transcript.

## SELECTION:

Selection of the scholarship recipient will be made by the Lancaster Scholarship Foundation Board of Directors.

## PAYMENT:

The scholarship recipient will receive payment after successfully completing his or her first semester and submitting proof of **full-time** enrollment in second semester at an accredited college. ***Successful completion of the first semester is defined as completing a minimum of 12 credit hours, not being on any type of academic probation status, or being dismissed from school.*** Proof of extenuating circumstances will be considered on an individual basis.
