

THE JIM HOEHL COMMUNITY VOLUNTEER LEADERSHIP MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP



(Lancaster Scholarship Foundation, Inc.)

The Jim Hoehl Community Volunteer Leadership Memorial Scholarship is created to recognize a deserving boy or girl who is pursuing a degree at either a two-year or four-year college. Primary consideration will be given to a student who has spent a minimum of two years with the same organization as a volunteer, with some leadership responsibilities. Consideration will also be given to applicant's citizenship and work ethic.

One scholarship in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) will be awarded annually to a qualified applicant.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Lancaster High School full-time senior, who has completed his or her last two years of high school at Lancaster High School. Grade point average is of no consideration. School attendance and graduation is required.
- 2. Must be enrolled in a post-secondary education program of at least one year in length.
- 3. Complete and submit the application form prior to the announced deadline. Please be specific.
- 4. **Submit at least one letter of recommendation from a <u>non-school staff</u> adult advisor/supervisor who has known the applicant within the last year-and-a-half and who can provide information as to the student's work/accomplishments.**
- 5. Attach a high school transcript.

SELECTION:

Selection of the scholarship recipient will be made by the Lancaster Scholarship Foundation Board of Directors.

PAYMENT:

The scholarship recipient will receive payment after successfully completing his or her first semester of schooling and proof of <u>full-time</u> enrollment in second semester at an accredited college. Successful completion of the first semester is defined as completing a <u>minimum of 12 credit hours</u>, not being on any type of academic probation status, or being dismissed from school. Proof of extenuating circumstances will be considered on an individual basis.
