



LANCASTER UNITED METHODIST MEN SCHOLARSHIP



The Lancaster United Methodist Men's Scholarship fund is created to encourage the pursuit of post-secondary education by providing financial assistance to graduating seniors at Lancaster High School.

This scholarship in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) will be awarded annually to a qualified applicant.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. The primary criteria considered when awarding this scholarship will be citizenship, community involvement and work ethic, with secondary consideration given to leadership and scholarship.
2. Applicant should include any interaction with mission work at the local, state, national or global level.
3. Lancaster High School full-time senior, who has completed his or her last two years of high school at Lancaster High School.
4. Must be enrolled in post-secondary education program of at least one year in length.
5. Complete and submit the application form prior to the announced deadline. Please be specific.
6. **Submit at least one letter of recommendation from a community member (not a school staff member).** Acceptable references must have known the applicant within the last year-and-a-half.
7. Attach a high school transcript.

SELECTION:

Selection of the scholarship recipient will be made by the Lancaster Scholarship Foundation Board of Directors.

PAYMENT:

The scholarship recipient will receive payment after successfully completing his or her first semester of schooling and proof of **full-time** enrollment in second semester at an accredited college. ***Successful completion of the first semester is defined as completing a minimum of 12 credit hours, not being on any type of academic probation status, or being dismissed from school.*** Proof of extenuating circumstances will be considered on an individual basis.
