

THE STANLEY NOBLE SCHOLARSHIP



(Lancaster Scholarship Foundation, Inc.)

The Stanley Noble Scholarship is designed to assist two Lancaster High School seniors (1 boy and 1 girl) in pursuing post-secondary education. The Lancaster Scholarship Foundation shall administer the scholarship funds and the recipient shall be determined in accordance with a selection process approved by the Board.

Two scholarships in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) each will be awarded annually to two qualified applicants (1 boy and 1 girl).

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Must be a Lancaster High School senior who has completed his or her last two years at Lancaster High School.
- 2. Must have a seven-semester, cumulative grade-point-average of 3.25 or higher.
- 3. Must be enrolled in a two-year associate's degree program or a four-year bachelor's degree program.
- 4. Primary consideration will be given to applicants who have participated in at least two athletic sports all four years and have displayed good sportsmanship throughout their high school career.
- 5. Must complete and submit the application form prior to the announced deadline.

PAYMENT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS:

The scholarship recipient will receive payment after successfully completing his or her first semester of schooling and proof of <u>full-time</u> enrollment in second semester at an accredited college. Successful completion of the first semester is defined as completing a <u>minimum of 12 credit hours</u>, not being on any type of academic probation status, or being dismissed from school. Proof of extenuating circumstances will be considered on an individual basis.
