

NELL SCHLEICHER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP



Lancaster Scholarship Foundation, Inc.

The Nell Schleicher Memorial Scholarship is created to recognize a deserving boy or girl who is pursuing a degree at either a two-year or four-year college. Primary consideration will be given to a student who is pursuing a degree in the field of health care to assist the recipient in meeting the cost of tuition and/or books.

If there are no applicants pursuing a health care degree, the scholarship will be awarded to someone who exhibits citizenship, community involvement and work ethic.

One scholarship in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) will be awarded annually to a qualified applicant.

QUALIFICATIONS and CONDITIONS:

The recipient of this scholarship must:

- 1. be a senior enrolled at Lancaster High School.
- 2. be enrolled in a four-year college or two-year technical college.
- 3. plan to pursue a degree in the field of health care, i.e. nursing, pre-medicine, pharmacy, therapy, etc.
- 4. demonstrate financial need as well as motivation and the ability to pursue education in one of the above-listed fields.

SELECTION:

Selection of the scholarship recipient will be made by the Lancaster Scholarship Foundation Board of Directors.

PAYMENT of the Scholarship Funds:

The scholarship recipient will receive payment after successfully completing his or her first semester of schooling and proof of **full-time enrollment** in second semester at an accredited college. *Successful completion* of the first semester is defined as completing a **minimum of 12 credit hours**, not being on any type of academic probation status, or being dismissed from school. Proof of extenuating circumstances will be considered on an individual basis.
