The Wisconsin Bank & Trust UW-Platteville College Scholarship Award is to be granted annually to a deserving senior boy or girl selected by a committee of the Lancaster Scholarship Foundation, Inc. The award is to be granted on the basis of leadership, talent, academic achievement, school and community service, and any other criteria available. Financial need may be considered but is not required as a criterion. Each scholarship shall be Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars.

The purpose of the award is to assist deserving candidates in meeting the costs of continued study at the University of Wisconsin - Platteville.

QUALIFICATIONS and CONDITIONS:

Candidates must:

1. Enroll at the University of Wisconsin – Platteville.
2. Choose a course/program of at least four years in length.
3. Submit written application to the counselor of Lancaster High School by the date established each year.

Application forms are available in the Guidance Office.

PAYMENT of the SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS:

The scholarship recipient will receive payment after successfully completing his or her first semester of schooling and proof of ***full-time*** enrollment in second semester at an accredited college. ***Successful completion of the first semester is defined as completing a minimum of 12 credit hours, not being on any type of academic probation status, or being dismissed from school.*** Proof of extenuating circumstances will be considered on an individual basis.
