

THE DOUG WOLF SCHOLARSHIP

(Lancaster Scholarship Foundation, Inc.)



The Doug Wolf Scholarship is awarded annually to a Lancaster High School wrestler or wrestling manager. Primary consideration will go to individuals who distinguished themselves through their work ethic and commitment to the wrestling program. The award is not designed to go to the most successful, but rather to the wrestler or manager who regularly "busted their backside" to be the best they could individually and for the team.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Be a wrestler or wrestling manager their senior year at Lancaster High School
- 2. Attend a two (2) year or four (4) year school/college.
- 3. Essay: In no more than one page, single spaced, respond to the following prompt:
 - Wrestling builds character. What values have you learned through your participation in wrestling that you will pay forward to others after high school?
- 4. <u>Optional</u>: You may submit one letter of recommendation. Recommendations from coaches are *not* acceptable.

SELECTION:

The selection committee will be approved by the family of Doug Wolf.

PAYMENT:

The scholarship recipient will receive payment after successfully completing his or her first semester and submitting proof of *full-time* enrollment in second semester at an accredited college. Successful completion of first semester is defined as completing a minimum of 12 credit hours, not being on any type of academic probation status, or being dismissed from school. Proof of extenuating circumstances will be considered on an individual basis.
