



THE “SHOT” AND JEANNE DOLL SCHOLARSHIP (Lancaster Scholarship Foundation, Inc.)



The “Shot” and Jeanne Doll Scholarship is created to recognize a deserving boy or girl who is pursuing a degree at either a two-year or four-year college. Primary consideration will be given to a student who is pursuing a degree in either a Business, Nursing or Automotive-related field. Secondary consideration will be given to all other majors and programs.

One scholarship in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) will be awarded annually to a qualified applicant.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Be a full-time senior who has completed their last two years of high school at Lancaster High School.
2. Be enrolled in a post-secondary education program of at least two years in length.
3. Complete and submit the application form prior to the announced deadline.
4. Attach a high school transcript.

SELECTION:

Selection of the scholarship recipient will be made by the Lancaster Scholarship Foundation Board of Directors.

PAYMENT:

The scholarship recipient will receive payment after successfully completing his or her first semester and submitting proof of full-time enrollment in second semester at an accredited college.

Successful completion of the first semester is defined as completing a minimum of 12 credit hours, not being on any type of academic probation status, or being dismissed from school. Proof of extenuating circumstances will be considered on an individual basis.
